### **Pastor's Perspective**

#### Come Walk the Week with Jesus

I believe this is one of the most important experiences of the church year.

I want to personally invite you to walk the full journey of Holy Week with us this year — not just Easter morning or even just Palm Sunday and Easter Sunday — but the *whole* story.

I know it can feel like a big commitment, but I encourage you to come to as many services as you can. It isn't quite as simple as Christmas. When we gather for the Christmas Eve Candlelight Service, we feel the joy and hope of the season all wrapped into one night. Though, I'd also tell you that coming every Sunday of Advent deepens that experience too.

Holy Week, however, is different. It is a *roller coaster* of emotions — honestly, more than I can even name. Joy, hope, pain, sacrifice, sin, repentance, love, and redemption all weave together. Holy Week helps us reflect on the reality that joy and hope often come in the midst of sorrow and sacrifice.

It all begins on **Palm Sunday**, when palm branches are waved and shouts of "Hosanna!" fill the air as we remember how Jesus entered Jerusalem, welcomed like a king. There's so much joy and excitement, but if you listen closely, you can already hear the tension underneath — the story is just beginning.

Then we gather on **Maundy Thursday**, one of the most tender and personal nights of the church year. I love this service because it always brings me face-to-face with Jesus' love — how He knelt and washed feet, shared a simple meal, and gave His friends (and us) the command to love one another.

On **Good Friday**, we stand at the foot of the cross. I'll be honest — this is always the hardest service for me. And yet, year after year, I am reminded how necessary it is to face the sorrow and sacrifice. We need to stand there, not to dwell in sadness, but to truly grasp the depth of His love. To try to grasp for ourselves in the midst of sorrow and sacrifice what is good about Good Friday.

And then, before the sun even fully rises on **Easter morning**, we gather for the **Sunrise Service**. The quiet, the beauty, the first light breaking through the darkness — it's one of my favorite moments of the year. There is something sacred about proclaiming "Christ is risen" as the new day dawns. Later that morning, our full **Easter worship** will be filled with joy and celebration as we sing and shout the good news together.

I hope you'll come to all of it. Not because you "should," but because each service tells part of the story we need — the story of hope, of love poured out, of life breaking through death. When we show up for the whole journey, Easter morning becomes more than a holiday. It becomes personal.

So, would you come? Walk the week with Jesus. Walk it with me. I promise, you'll be glad you did.


